WHEREAS, Louis J. Travalini is the owner of certain parcels of land located within the Town of Frankford municipal limits being Property Map Numbers 433-6.18-48.00, 433-8-6.18-48.08, 433-6.18-48.02 and 433-6.18-48.01; and
