

RESOLUTION 2024-0007

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE
SUSSEX COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS the Town of Frankford has experienced natural hazards that result in public safety hazards and damage to private and public property;

WHEREAS the hazard mitigation planning process set forth by the State of Delaware and the Federal Emergency Management Agency offers the opportunity to consider natural hazards and risks and identify mitigation actions to reduce future risk;

WHEREAS a hazard mitigation plan ("Plan") was developed by the Sussex County Mitigation Planning Committee and Working Group;

WHEREAS the Plan includes a prioritized list of mitigation actions—including activities that, over time, will help minimize and reduce safety threats and damage to private and public property; and

WHEREAS a draft plan was provided to each participating jurisdiction and posted on the County Office of Emergency Management's website so as to (1) introduce the planning concept and solicit questions and comments and (2) present the plan and request comments as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Frankford that the Sussex County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, as approved by the Delaware Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency on June 6, 2022, is hereby adopted as an official plan of the Town of Frankford.
